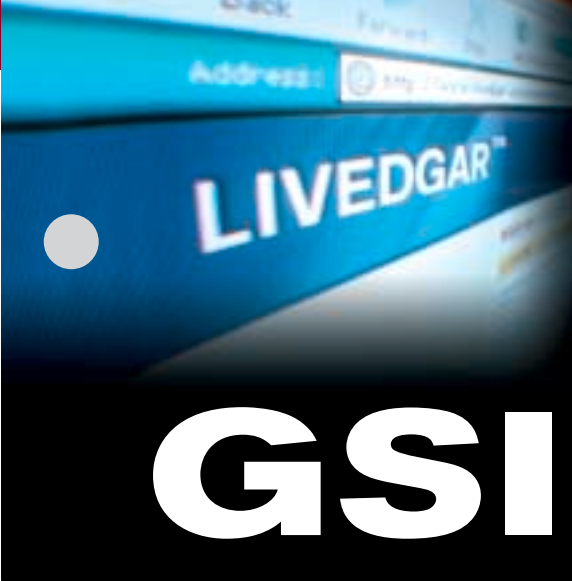

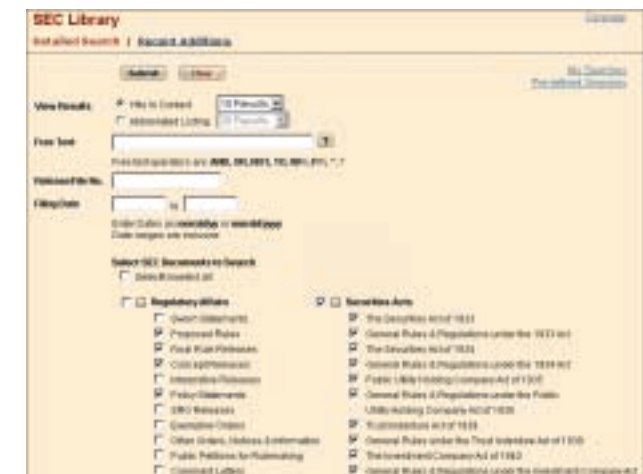
New Form 8-K Effective This Summer

In order to provide investors with better and faster disclosure of important corporate events, the SEC recently released a Final Rule expanding the number of events that are reportable on Form 8-K and shortening the filing deadline. The new Form 8-K will be effective on August 23, 2004.

If you are not familiar with what is reported in SEC forms, exhibits and schedules, or do not like developing your own search statements, the Topical Research Library is a great place to begin your LIVEDGAR searches.

Now Available in LIVEDGAR – Centralized Company Exhibits

Now available in LIVEDGAR, the new Company Exhibits feature aggregates a company's exhibits, making it easy for you to quickly locate selected exhibits such as articles, bylaws, employment agreements and other information commonly found in exhibits to SEC filings.

Accessible from the Company Filings page, the Company Exhibits link produces a complete listing of a company's exhibits, detailing the exhibit number, description, related form type, file date, period and number of pages. For maximum ease-of-use, you can sort the exhibits list on any of the above fields to locate and view the specific exhibits you need. Furthermore, if the filer neglects to include a title for an exhibit, GSI will provide one based on SEC naming guidelines and rules.



Using convenient check boxes, exhibits you select can easily be added to your Worklist or included in a TDR. Furthermore, the new Exhibits Report link quickly generates a nicely formatted report listing all the exhibits, which you can view, print, e-mail or save.

Finally, for added convenience, two links at the top of the Company Exhibits page simplify searching within exhibits, and locating exhibits attached to a company's

most recent 10-K. The Search Exhibits link takes you to the Full-Text Search page, where you can further refine your search, and where the CIK number of the company you are searching is automatically populated. The Most Recent 10-K link shows all exhibits attached to the company's most recent 10-K.

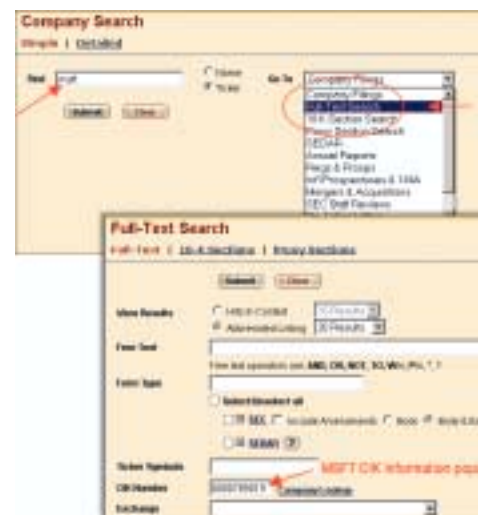

One-Step Searching by Ticker Symbol Delivers Key Company Information

GSI is pleased to announce Ticker Search – a convenient new LIVEDGAR feature enabling one-step searching by ticker symbol for specific types of company information.

From the Company Search page, a similar drop-down box is available for searching by company, providing all the same options found in the drop-down box on the Main Menu, plus four additional options. These four additional options – Full-Text, 10-K Section, Proxy Section

screen and take you to that screen. From there, you'll see that the CIK Number of the company you've selected has been entered. At this point, you may also enter additional search criteria to further refine your search. All search results will be restricted to the company you originally selected.



Now, from LIVEDGAR's Main Menu, you can simply enter a ticker symbol and select the type of information you want to see from a drop-down menu. Options include Company Filings, Annual Reports, Registrations & Prospectuses, International Prospectuses & 144A, Mergers & Acquisitions, SEC Staff Reviews, No-Action Letters, Company Roundup and News, Quotes & Financials.

and SEDAR – automatically insert the CIK Number of the company you are searching into the appropriate search

For example, enter the MSFT ticker in the box on the Company Search page, select Full-Text Search from the drop-down box and click Submit. LIVEDGAR will take you to the Full-Text Search page, which will already be populated with Microsoft's CIK Number. From here, you can further refine your search by adding additional search criteria.
